HARNARESH SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

Through this petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.179 dated 01.10.2021, registered under Sections 420, 406, 465, 467, 468, 471 IPC, at Police Station Kotwali, District Bathinda.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that from the other arrested co-accused, namely, Nitin Aggarwal, Gurdarshan Lal, Sarwan Lal, Deepak Kumar, Baljit Kumar and Sunny Kumar, nothing was recovered; that the petitioner has falsely been involved in the present case and that nothing is to be recovered from the petitioner. He further submits that the petitioner has been indicted in the present case on the basis of the disclosure statement of co-accused, namely, Nitin Aggarwal.

On the other hand, learned State counsel, while opposing the prayer for grant of regular bail to the petitioner submits that from the co-accused recovery has already been effected. He further submits that some

of the accused persons were using fake documents, in order to get sanctioned the loan from various banks, which had been prepared by the petitioner. Still further, it is submitted that the petitioner used to prepare forge and fabricated Aadhaar Card mentioning fake details and that the petitioner along with other co-accused has committed fraud with various persons, by using the said fake and fabricated documents.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

The petitioner is a member of a gang that had been involved in getting sanctioned loan(s) from the banks on the basis of fake and forged documents of various persons. Such acts of impersonation, fraud and forgery, are serious offences and shake the very fabric of an orderly civilized society.

Keeping in view the seriousness and gravity of the offence, no case is made out to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Dismissed.
