The petitioners have filed the present petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 5 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and their workers/members/drivers from danger at the hands of respondents No.6 to 10.

Notice of motion to the official respondents.

Mr. C.L. Pawar, Senior Deputy Advocate General, Punjab has accepted notice on behalf of the official respondents. Let copy of the paper book be supplied to him.

Heard.

The present petition has come about by the petitioners claiming that the petitioners are President and Vice-President of a registered Firm and had entered into an agreement with M/s Chaudhary Transport Company for supplying trucks for the work of handling and transportation of food grains from Food Corporation of India/State Government Godowns to railhead at Moga including local mandis etc.

and that the private respondents No.6 to 10 are trying to oust them and create hurdles in the smooth transportation of the food grains.

In the light of the same and keeping in view the averments made in the petition and the contentions raised by the counsel for the petitioners, the present petition is disposed of with the directions to the official respondents to ensure due protection of life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents, which is not opposed by the learned State counsel Mr. C.L. Pawar, Senior Deputy Advocate General, Punjab and to ensure that there is no interruption in the free and smooth transportation of the food grains by the petitioners.
