ANIL KSHETARPAL, J.

The petitioner claims that she was selected for pre-commissioning training in military nursing services. She completed the course and the training but was found to be medically unfit – Bilateral Granular Corneal Dystrophy. Accordingly, the petitioner was declared incompetent on medical grounds and invalidated out on 04.03.2016.

The petitioner through the present writ petition prays for issuance of a writ for quashing the order dated 04.03.2016. In fact, the petitioner prays that she may be commissioned in military nursing services.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner challenges the order dated 19.10.2020 vide which legal notice sent by her was replied.

It is apparent that the petitioner was declared incompetent on medical grounds on 04.03.2016. The petitioner has filed this writ petition in December, 2020. Thus, the writ petition has been filed after a

long unexplained delay of more than 4 years and 9 months. Hence, this Court is not inclined to issue a writ.

Dismissed.
