This application is for placing on record the affidavit and receipt executed by the complainant as Annexures P-4 & P-5 respectively.

Heard through video conferencing. For the reasons stated in the application, the same is allowed and Annexures P-4 & P-5 are taken on record.

Main case

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.16 dated 20.01.2019, under Sections 120-B, 406, 420 & 506 IPC (Sections 419, 467, 468 and 471 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Bhondsi, District Gurugram, Haryana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations in the FIR are that the petitioner has duped the complainant for a sum of Rs.4,50,000/- on the pretext of advancing her interest free loan. He, however, contends that the FIR was registered on the basis of a misunderstanding which

has now been resolved and the matter has been compromised. He has referred to the affidavit of the complainant and receipt issued by her at Annexures P-4 & P-5 respectively. He also contends that the petitioner is in custody for about 06 months.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Vinod Kumar, contends that although challan has been filed but charges are yet to be framed.

Heard through video conferencing.

In view of the above especially when the petitioner is in custody for about 06 months, the matter has been compromised, the COVID-19 pandemic and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
