This criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226 Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for directing respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners, who are apprehending threats at the hands of respondent Nos.4 and 5.

On 18.12.2020, the following order was passed by this Court:

“Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners are receiving threats from respondent Nos.4 and 5 as they have entered into marriage on 14.12.2020 against their wishes.

Notice of motion to respondent Nos.1 to 3 only, at this stage.

Mr. Amar Ashok Pathak, Addl.A.G, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of official respondents. Counsel for the petitioners undertakes to forward the complete copy of the petition to the office of Advocate General Punjab through e-mail, during the course of the day.

Learned State counsel prays for time to verify the facts and the existence of alleged threat.

On his request, adjourned to 11.01.2021. ”

Today learned State counsel has produced the joint statement of the petitioners and stated that as on today, they are not facing any threat

and do not need any protection.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners states that the petition is rendered infructuous.
