The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a direction to official respondents No. 1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner, as he apprehends threats at the hand of the police official, respondent No.4 on the behest of respondents No. 5 and 6.

A copy of the petition was served upon the State counsel, who has filed reply by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police (Rural), Patiala, wherein it has been deposed as under:-

“3. That the above noted application was marked to the Superintendent of Police (Traffic), Patiala by the S.S.P. Patiala to conduct the enquiry in the matter. So, the petitioner was summoned by the enquiry officer and during enquiry, the respondent No.4 recorded the statements of both the parties. After completing the enquiry in the matter, the enquiry officer submitted its enquiry vide No.149/C/S.P./Traffic, Patiala dated 21.12.2020. Copy of the enquiry report is attached herewith as Annexure R-1/T.

4. That the petitioner also filed application No.6402/Peshi dated 10.10.2020, 4610/OP dated 25.11.2020 before the S.S.P. Patiala and these applications were marked to SHO, Police Station Sanaur District Patiala for conducting the enquiry in the matter. During the enquiry the petitioner got recorded his statement that he has filed case in the Hon'ble Civil Court, so whatever the decision is taken by the learned Court, the same will be acceptable to him. Copy of the statement of the petitioner is attached herewith as Annexure R-2/T. Copy of the enquiry report No.503, 505/5C/Sanaur dated 31.12.2020 submitted by SHO, P.S.Sanaur to senior officer is attached herewith as Annexure R-3/T. So, the application filed by the

*petitioner before the S.S.P. Patiala were consigned to
record room.”*

In view of the above development, no order is called for.
Petition is disposed of.
