On 18.12.2020, the following order was passed :-

“The petitioner has participated for the post of Junior System Engineer in the Department of Dakshin Haryana Bijli Vitran Nigam. After qualifying the written test, he was called for scrutiny of documents on 11.11.2020 and 12.11.2020. However, he could not participate for scrutiny of documents as he was suffering from typhoid. He has also placed on record medical card alongwith lab reports (Annexure P-4) to show that he was suffering from typhoid and his daughter was also suffering from high grade fever and vomiting.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Hitesh Pandit, Additional Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.

Since the final result has not been declared so far, direction is given to the respondents to scrutinize the documents of the petitioner on 21.12.2020 and the final result of the petitioner shall be kept in a sealed cover.

Learned State counsel submits that the petitioner has already been permitted to appear for scrutiny of documents on 19.01.2021 and his name is being considered by the Department. She submits that the writ petition has been rendered infructuous.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the name of the petitioner may not be considered by the Department.

Learned State counsel assures the Court that the recruitment of the petitioner shall be considered in accordance with law.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the writ petition is disposed of.
