Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.48 dated 09.06.2019, under Sections 406, 498-A of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Women Cell, Patiala.

Vide order dated 14.01.2020, the petitioners were directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that pursuant to order dated 14.01.2020, petitioners have joined the investigation and have fully cooperated with the Investigating Officer.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Balwant Singh submits that petitioner No.2-Jaswant Kaur has been declared innocent and petitioner No.1-Tejinder Singh Chawla has joined the investigation and is not required for any purpose.

In view of the above, interim order dated 14.01.2020 is made absolute *qua* petitioner No.1-Tejinder Singh Chawla subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the petition has become infructuous *qua* petitioner No.2-Jaswant Kaur and is dismissed as such.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
