By way of present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, a prayer for extension of emergency parole for a period of two months has been made on medical grounds/humanitarian grounds, as the condition of the petitioner is critical and he is suffering from many ailments as mentioned in Annexures P-3 and P-4, respectively.

Earlier, the petitioner was extended the concession of parole on medical grounds vide order dated 21.09.2021 (Annexure P-1), of this Court.

Learned State Counsel has placed on record the medical report of the petitioner from Civil Hospital, Malout, District Muktsar Sahib. It has been submitted that the condition of the petitioner continues to be precarious and hence likely to continue to be hospitalized in Civil Hospital, Malout, District Muktsar Sahib for more time.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, keeping in view the medical report placed on record today by State Counsel, this Court deems it appropriate to order the release of the petitioner on Parole on medical grounds.

Accordingly, the petition is allowed and petitioner is ordered to be released on parole for a further period of two months from the date of release on furnishing of requisite personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the authorities concerned.
