This is a petition that has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking direction to the respondent to present the challan after arresting the accused in FIR No.0025, dated 13.02.2019, under Sections 325, 323, 34 of IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar, Fazilka.

Pursuant to the notice of motion being issued, reply has been filed and the same is taken on record. As per the reply dated 20.08.2021 which is filed by way of affidavit of Jasbir Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division, Fazilka, District Fazilka, the matter stands investigated and the challan was prepared on 12.06.2021. Two accused, namely, Gurdeep Singh and Hardeep Singh were arrested by the police and now they are on bail, whereas three accused, namely, Inderjeet

Singh, Raj Singh and Gurwinder Singh were found to be innocent. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Lakhwinder Singh, would submit that after the filing of said reply, challan already stands presented on 17.11.2021.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and in view of the limited prayer made, this petition has been rendered infructuous as the challan stands presented.

Dismissed as infructuous.

However, any grievance the petitioner might have, he is competent to take his recourse in accordance with law.
