The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

The petitioner is a resident of the village Rajpur Bhaian, Tehsil and District Hoshiarpur. The petitioner prays for issuance of an appropriate writ of Mandamus to direct the respondents to decide representation dated 18.10.2021/21.10.2021. The grievance of the petitioner is that the respondent-Gram Panchayat is not maintaining the cleanliness of the pond already in existence, besides, the Gram Panchayat is planning to dig a new pond.

In the considered view of this Court, the High Court while exercising the writ jurisdiction under Article 226 of the Constitution of India does not have expertise to decide as to whether there should be one or two ponds in the village.

Hence, disposed of.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
