ARUN MONGA, J. (ORAL)

Petition herein *inter-alia* is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing respondent No.2 to conduct interview of the petitioner for the post of Wildlife Guard.

2. Learned State counsel submits that petitioner has not made the cut as the minimum score required to qualify the written examination in the Outstanding Sports Person-Scheduled Caste (OSP-SC) category, in which the petitioner has applied, is 76 marks.

3. Perusal of the result reveals that the petitioner has secured 58 marks as against the cut-off, i.e. 76 marks.

4. Result of the petitioner is not under challenge before this Court. It seems that petitioner was under wrong impression at the time of filing the instant petition that based on his performance in the OSP-SC Category, in which he had applied, he would qualify for the next round. Being not so, no grounds to interfere are made out. Dismissed.
