The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioners have invoked the jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking prayer by way of writ of mandamus for issuance of directions to the respondents to count the entire service rendered by the petitioners from the date of their initial appointment as qualifying service for the purpose of retiral benefits and pay, with a further direction to the respondents to refix the retiral benefits and pay all arrears on that account along with interest @ 12% p.a.; as well as to decide the legal notice dated 04.04.2021 (Annexure P-3).

Heard.

Notice of motion to the official respondents.

Ms. Simran Grewal, Asst. Advocate General, Punjab puts in appearance and accepts notice on behalf of the said respondents. Copy of the paper book has been supplied to her.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the parties and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with direction to the respondents to consider the legal notice dated 04.04.2021 (Annexure P-3) as representation of the petitioners and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the release of payment, the same be granted to the petitioners without any delay, as per law.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
