The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.100 dated 27.11.2020, under Sections 22 and 29 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Dharamgarh, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that no recovery has been effected from the petitioner and recovery of 120 tablets of clovidol containing tramadol and 60 tablets of Alprasafe containing Alprazolam have been recovered from the co-accused. This recovery is of non-commercial quantity. The petitioner is not involved in any other case under the NDPS Act.

This Court, by the order dated 18.12.2020, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Gursewak Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 18.12.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
