Respondent No.4 had filed an application for correction of khasra girdawari. The application was dismissed. He challenged the order by way of appeal and the same was allowed. The appellate order was challenged by the petitioners before the Financial Commissioner, but the same has been dismissed as not maintainable on account of amendment in Section 16 of the Punjab Land Revenue Act, 1887 by Haryana Act No.12 of 2017. Thus, present writ petition has been filed.

A perusal of the amended provision shows that the Commissioner can exercise the powers of revision under Section 16 of the aforementioned Act and not the Financial Commissioner. Thus, learned counsel for the petitioners wishes to withdraw this petition with liberty to approach the concerned Commissioner.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the aforementioned liberty. In case, an issue of limitation arises, the same shall be considered sympathetically.
