B.S. Walia, J. (VC)

1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that grievance of the petitioner is qua non-inclusion of his name for allotment of 200 sq. yds plot under the Oustees Quota.
3. Mr. Sehajbir Singh, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents on instructions from Sh. Sukhdev Singh, Asstt. Estate Officer, GAMADA states that draw of allotment of 200 sq.yds plots under the oustees quota is to be held on 09.02.2021 and that the name of the petitioner would be included in said draw of lots.
4. The same satisfies learned counsel for the petitioner, who states that in the circumstances, he does not press the contempt petition and the same may be disposed of as such at this stage with liberty to the petitioner to move an application for revival of the contempt petition, if

the circumstances of the case, so warrant.

5. Accordingly, in view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the contempt petition is disposed of as not pressed with the liberty as prayed for.
