The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in F.I.R. No. 358 dated 11.10.2020, under Sections 120-B, 148, 307, 323, 341 and 365 IPC read with Section 149 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Sadar Fazilka, District Fazilka.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 17.12.2020, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from Inspector Baldev Singh, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 17.12.2020, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
