Both cases have been taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing.

Reply dated 03.11.2021 by way of affidavit of Aaswant Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, City-2, Bathinda, along with Annexure R/1 already filed on behalf of respondent-State (in CRM-M-43089-2020), is taken on record.

Learned counsel for petitioners as well as learned counsel for complainant submit that compromise dated 26.04.2021 (Annexure R/1) has already been arrived at between the parties, in terms of which, petitioners

namely Pramod Kumar and Pankaj Kumar have agreed to pay a sum of Rs.25,00,000/- in lump sum in favour of complainant-Sunny Singla, Proprietor of M/s Singla Agencies, Guru Ki Nagri, Mansa Road, Bathinda.

In view of above, petitioners are required to comply with the terms and conditions as set up in the compromise deed dated 26.04.2021 (Annexure R/1) in letter and spirit.

Learned State counsel on instructions from Sub Inspector Gurwinder Singh submits that in compliance of order dated 21.12.2020, petitioners have already joined investigation and are not required for further investigation or any kind of custodial interrogation.

In view of above, order dated 21.12.2020 granting interim bail to petitioners, is made absolute. Petitioners shall abide by the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. in letter and spirit.

Petitions are disposed of accordingly.
