By this petition, the petitioner seeks quashing of FIR No.215, dated 10.07.2020, registered at Police Station Sirhali, District Tarn Taran, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under Section 429 of the IPC and Section 11(1) of the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act, 1960, as also all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of a compromise arrived at between the parties. A copy of the compromise deed has also been annexed as Annexure P-2 with the petition.

As recorded in the order dated 12.10.2021, this Court had been informed by learned counsel for the petitioner that the offences punishable under the provisions of Sections 25/27 of the Arms Act, 1959, had also been added one of the offences allegedly committed by the petitioner.

Today, an affidavit dated 16.11.2021 having been filed by the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Patti, it is ordered to be taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the outset, submits that the petitioner does not wish to pursue this petition.
