The petitioner has challenged the order dated 04.05.2021 whereby he has been declared as a proclaimed person in FIR No.119 dated 15.12.2020, under Sections 457, 380 IPC, registered at Police Station Smalsar, District Moga.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that there is a delay of two months in registering the FIR wherein it is alleged that LCC cards etc. were stolen from the telephone exchange. The petitioner is stated to be a ragpicker and some stolen material is alleged to have been recovered from his house. He also contends that the petitioner could not be served at his native place in Uttar Pardesh and therefore, he could not appear before the trial Court and had been declared as a proclaimed person. He, however, contends that he wants to withdraw this petition as the petitioner shall be surrendering before the trial Court.

The petition is dismissed as withdrawn.

In the event of the petitioner surrendering and preferring an application for regular bail, the same shall be decided in accordance with law expeditiously.
