Petitioner-Balvir Singh Virdi, has filed the present petition *inter alia* with a prayer for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the official respondents to take action on the representation dated 19.08.2020 (Annexure P-3).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per the transfer policy dated 16.12.2019 (Annexure P-2), an employee who makes a request for posting at desired station, may submit a written request. Learned counsel then submits that the petitioner submitted a written request on 19.08.2020 (Annexure P-3), but no action has been taken till date.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Ankush Aggarwal, Advocate,

accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 & 2 and submits that he has no objection if the prayer made, be accepted.

In view of the peculiar facts and circumstances as noticed above and without commenting upon merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.1/competent authority to decide the written request/representation dated 19.08.2020 (Annexure P-3) by passing a speaking order within **two months** from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
