The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.448 dated 23.09.2020 under Sections 379-A, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Sector-58, Faridabad, District Faridabad.

The allegation against the petitioner is that he along with other co-accused Dharambir Singh snatched the mobile make OPPO AIK from the complainant.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody since 24.09.2020 and trial in the case is not likely to be concluded in the near future.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from SI Dharam Vir, does not dispute the custody period of the petitioner.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

The petitioner is in custody since 24.09.2020. Trial in the case is not likely to be concluded in the near future, thus, this Court deems it appropriate to admit the petitioner on bail.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is admitted on regular bail, subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
