The matter has been taken up through Video conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioner has come up in this civil writ petition under articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a prayer by way of writ of *certiorari quashing* the pension payment order dated 04.08.2021 (Annexure P-4) issued by the respondent No. 4 and a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to refix the pension of the petitioner on the salary as he was getting on the date of superannuation with all consequential benefits alongwith interest @ 18% per annum, for which, representations dated 25.08.2021 (Annexure P-5 and P-6, respectively) have also been submitted before the

respondent-authorities.

Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, the directions are issued to the respondent-authorities to duly consider the representations dated 25.08.2021 (Annexures P-5 and P-6) and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably, within a period of one month from the date of passing of this order.

If the petitioner is held entitled for so claimed relief and there is no impediment for granting the same, the relief be released to him without any delay as per law.
