This is a petition that has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.254, dated 19.10.2021, registered under Sections 379-B, 34 IPC at Police Station Anaj Mandi, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the said FIR. Neither any alleged recovery was effected from her nor was she in any way criminally liable in the case. The petitioner is in custody since 19.10.2021. Moreover, the matter has been compromised between the parties and a separate petition i.e. CRM-M-48825-2021 on the basis of compromise has been filed, which is pending consideration.

Learned State counsel opposes the grant of regular bail to the petitioner referring to seriousness of the allegations.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 19.10.2021 and the fact that the matter has been compromised between the parties, no useful purpose would be served in keeping the petitioner behind the bars any longer. Accordingly, the instant petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on execution of adequate personal bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate. However, any observation made herein shall not be construed to be an expression of opinion on merits of the case.
