Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in compliance with the order dated 21.12.2020, the petitioner has since joined the investigation on 28.12.2020 and has been released on interim bail.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Om Parkash concedes this fact, further stating that under the circumstances, custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not needed and she is not required by the police for further investigation.

It being so, the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 21.12.2020 is made absolute, subject to the following conditions:-

- 1.that the petitioner shall make herself available for investigation by a police officer as and when required;
- 2.that she shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer and;
- 3.that she shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court.
- 4.that she shall surrender her passport before the Investigating Officer and if she is not having passport, then, shall file the affidavit in that regard.

In case, the petitioner violates any terms & conditions, on which the bail has been granted to her, the prosecution would be entitled to apply for cancellation of bail.

The petition stands allowed accordingly.
