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RAVI SHANKER JHA, CHIEF JUSTICE (oral)

This petition has been filed by the petitioner allegedly in public interest praying for a direction to the respondent-authorities to deposit in government treasury all the money/charges/fee collected by them. It is observed that the petitioner had previously filed a CWP-PIL No. 153 of 2021 before this Court which was disposed of vide order dated 27.08.2021 by taking the statement of learned Additional Advocate General, Punjab on record that if any such representation is filed by the petitioner, the competent authority shall consider and decide the same expeditiously preferably within a period of two months.

Apparently, the petitioner has thereafter made a representation dated 02.09.2021 (Annexure P-11) before the competent authority. The petitioner has now approached this Court by filing the second writ petition praying for a same relief as well as for interim relief that no decision on the aforesaid representation has been taken by the respondent-authority till date.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner, we are of the considered opinion that the second petition for the same relief is not maintainable. The petition is accordingly dismissed reiterating the previous order dated 27.08.2021 passed in CWP-PIL No. 153 of 2021.
