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RAVI SHANKER JHA, C.J. (ORAL)

This appeal has been filed by the appellant against the judgment and order dated 17.02.2020 passed by the learned Single Judge whereby the petition filed by the appellant-petitioner against his order of termination dated 30.07.2011 has been dismissed on the ground of delay and latches.

When confronted with the fact that this Court did not find any illegality, impropriety or perversity in the impugned order passed by the learned Single Judge, learned senior counsel for the appellant submits that the appellant may at least be granted liberty to raise the issue for grant of arrears of service benefits, if any, outstanding with the respondent-authorities.

In view of the aforesaid circumstances and in view of the aforesaid prayer made by learned senior counsel for the appellant, while the appeal filed by the appellant is dismissed upholding the order passed by the learned Single Judge, the right of the appellant-petitioner to approach the respondent-authorities is left open in case the appellant-petitioner feels that some retiral benefits or payment of dues that are otherwise admissible have not been paid to him.
