1. Prayer in the petition under Articles 226 / 227 of the Constitution of India, is for the issuance of a writ, in the nature of Mandamus for directing respondent No.2 to re-evaluate the marks of the petitioner by adding 2 additional marks on account of work experience of 4 years and 2 months, as a Computer Instructor at the office of Government Industrial Training Institute Women, Charkhi Dadri, which is equivalent to the post of Sub Inspector, as provided in the rules and regulations and Advt. No.3/2021 dated 15.06.2021.

2. At the outset, learned counsel contends that the petitioner has submitted representation (Annexure P-20) dated 08.11.2021, but the same has not been decided till date, therefore, in the circumstances, the petitioner would be satisfied, if the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the claim made in representation (Annexure P-20) dated 08.11.2021, in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion to respondent No.2 only.

4. Mr. Tapan Kumar, learned DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.2 and after perusal of the writ petition states that he has no objection to the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

5. Accordingly, in view of the statement of learned counsel for the parties, but without commenting upon the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide representation (Annexure P-20) dated 08.11.2021, in accordance with law after taking into account all aspects of the matter within 06 weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

6. Petition disposed of with the aforementioned directions.
