The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.0182 dated 02.06.2021, under Sections 307, 148, 149 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Jandiala, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that there is a delay of two days in registering the FIR. He further contends that the alleged injury attributed to the petitioner is simple in nature. The petitioner is 23 year of age and, therefore, he would be entitled to the protection from arrest.

Heard.

The allegations against the petitioner are that he along with the co-accused Rahwal @ Dana has caused fire arm injuries to the complainant. This is the second petition preferred for anticipatory bail. The earlier petition bearing CRM No.M-38957-2021 was dismissed on 27.09.2021.

In view of the above, I do not deem it find any good ground to take another view in the mater and grant concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Consequently, the petition stands dismissed.
