AMOL RATTAN SINGH, J. (Oral)Case heard *via* video conferencing.

By this petition, the petitioner seeks the concession of 'regular bail' under the provisions of Section 439 Cr.P.C., upon FIR No.232, dated 03.09.2019, having been registered at Police Station Islamabad, District Amritsar, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under the provisions of Sections 307/120-B/148/149/506 IPC and Section 52 of the Prisons Act, 1894.

The petitioner having been in custody for more than 2 years and 3 months now even as per the custody certificate filed in court today by the learned State counsel, and with no prosecution witness stated to have been examined, as per the instructions of learned State counsel, even though there are many other FIRs shown to be registered against him, however in the context of the FIR in question, simply on the ground of the long period of custody, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, the

petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be admitted to bail, upon him furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial court/CJM/Duty Magistrate concerned.
