The matter has been taken up through Video conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioner has come up in this civil writ petition under articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* directing the respondent to decide the representations dated 23.04.2019 and 20.08.2020 (Annexure P-1 and P-2 respectively) submitted by the petitioner for the release of service benefits in accordance with the service rules.

In view of the averments made in the petition, the directions are issued to the respondent-authorities to duly

consider the representations dated 23.04.2019 and 20.08.2020 (Annexures P-1 and P-2, respectively) and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably, within a period of one month from the date of passing of this order.

If the petitioner is held entitled for so claimed relief and there is no impediment for granting the same, the relief be released to him without any delay as per law.
