The instant Petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking Regular Bail on behalf of the Petitioner in case FIR No.0147, dated 11.09.2021, registered under Sections 379-B, 323, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Sadar Ferozepur, District Ferozepur.

2. The Petitioner has remained in detention for two months and five days since 16.09.2021.

3. He was not named in the original FIR. The stolen mobile phone has since been recovered from a co-accused namely Monu.

4. The Complainant has entered into a compromise with the said Monu as can be seen from Annexure P-3.

5. In the circumstances, considering the long detention undergone by the Petitioner, at this stage, he is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
