Petitioner herein *inter alia* seeks issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the impugned order dated 23.06.2021 (Annexure P-8) vide which his services from the post of Peon (Group-D) have been terminated for not submitting the sports gradation certificate in terms of the Government Instructions dated 10.11.2020.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner relies on a Circular/letter dated 15.09.2021 (Annexure P-9) issued by the Office of Chief Secretary to Government of Haryana addressed to all the Administrative Secretaries/ Heads of Department, conveying them that Director, Sports and Youth Affairs, Haryana shall now issue fresh Sports Gradation Certificates in terms of Sports Policy dated 25.05.2018 on or before 31.10.2021. He submits that petitioner gave an application on 30.09.2021 to respondent No.4, namely, District Sports and Youth Affairs Officer, Fatehabad for issuance of a gradation certificate, but the same is still pending. Hence, the instant petition.

3. Learned State counsel, on advance service, joins proceedings and states that competent authority shall take decision on the pending representation/application dated 30.09.2021 (Annexure P-11) in due course.

4. At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner also agrees that let a final decision be taken, either way, by the competent authority on the pending application/representation dated 30.09.2021 (Annexure P-11), giving reasons thereof.

5. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by any of the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

6. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority to look into the grievance of the petitioner as per representation dated 30.09.2021 (Annexure P-11) and also by keeping in view the contention raised in the present petition by treating the same as supplementary representation and take a decision, in accordance with law.

7. Let the needful be done within a period of 60 days from today.

8. Disposed of accordingly.
