The present petition has been filed by the petitioner seeking direction to official respondents to protect the life and liberty and property of petitioner and other members of his family.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that respondent No.4 is wife whereas respondents No.5 and 6 are in-laws of petitioner and matrimonial dispute is going on between the petitioner and his wife. According to her, there is apprehension in the mind of petitioner that he will be falsely implicated in some case by the police at the behest of respondents No.4 to 6 and in this regard representation dated 23.04.2021(Annexure P-2) has already been given to respondent No.2, but the police authorities have failed to take any action on the same. She further submits that petitioner will be satisfied if necessary direction is given to respondent No.2 to consider the aforesaid representation, in accordance with law.

Notice of motion.

Mr. H.S. Multani, AAG Punjab accepts notice on behalf of

respondents No.1 to 3 and submits that in case any such representation is pending, then the police authorities will consider and decide the same in a time bound manner.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of case, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to firstly verify the contents of representation (Annexure P-2) and then to consider and take action thereupon, as per law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of this order.
