By this petition, the petitioner seeks the concession of 'anticipatory bail' under the provisions of Section 438 Cr.P.C., upon FIR No.96, dated 16.08.2020, having been registered at Police Station Nandgarh, District Bathinda, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under the provisions of Sections 307/323/341/427/148/149 of the IPC.

Pursuant to the order dated 12.11.2021, learned State counsel submits, on instructions ASI Menga Singh, that the petitioner has joined investigation and presently at least his custodial interrogation is not required.

That being so, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, the petition is allowed, with the order dated 12.11.2021, made absolute on the same terms and conditions.
