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HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

The case is taken up through video conferencing on account of COVID 2019.

Petitioners who are allottees of surplus land have filed CWP-29098-2018 alleging that even after issuance of US-3 Certificate on 8.3.1981, they had not been handed over possession. An affidavit of Sub Divisional Officer (Civil), Sirsa was filed, as per which possession of land allotted to petitioners had been handed over to them and necessary rapats in this regard had also been entered. In view thereof, the petition was disposed of vide order dated 14.1.2019 as having been rendered as infructuous.

The grievance of petitioners is that despite possession having been handed over to them, the land owners are not permitting them to utilize the land. Infact, they have also forcibly harvested crops sown by petitioners. Petitioners have submitted representation/complaint in this regard to local police, however, no action thereon has been taken.

No direction can be issued in this contempt petition as there appears to be no wilful disobedience of any order or direction issued by this Court. However, it will be open to the petitioners to avail of any other remedy in accordance with law against those who have interfered with their possession.

Disposed of accordingly.
