The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for setting aside the order dated 05.03.2020 (Annexure P-2) passed by learned Judge, Special Court, Chandigarh, whereby the petitioner has been declared as proclaimed offender in FIR No.45, dated 31.01.2018, registered under Section 21 of the NDPS Act, 1985 at Police Station South, Sector 34, Chandigarh (Annexure P-1).

Notice of motion.

At this stage, Mr. C.S. Bakshi, APP, UT, Chandigarh, has put in appearance and accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-UT, Chandigarh. He opposes the petition by relying upon copy of order dated 15.02.2019 passed by the trial Court and submits that the petitioner had wilfully absented from trial.

At this stage, counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the instant petition and would submit that the petitioner would surrender before the trial Court and his bail application may be considered expeditiously.

In view of the request made, the petition is disposed of as withdrawn with an observation that in case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court within one week and moves application for bail, that will be considered within one week of its filing.
