This writ petition has been preferred by the petitioner where in compliance with the order passed by this Court in an earlier writ petition preferred by the petitioner i.e. CRWP-9751-2021, was disposed of by this Court on 13.10.2021 (Annexure P-2), directing the respondents to consider the representation dated 24.09.2021 filed by the petitioner and take a decision thereon within a period of one week. In pursuance to the said order, two weeks' parole for agricultural purposes was granted to the petitioner vide order dated 27.10.2021 (Annexure P-3). Through this petition, extension for parole is being sought for the reason that within a short span of two weeks, he has not been able to complete the agricultural work.

We do find two weeks' parole having been granted to the petitioner too less to carry out the agricultural work especially when it has not been mentioned that the petitioner has very small piece of land. We, therefore, extend the parole already granted to the petitioner for agricultural purposes by another two weeks'.

The writ petition stands disposed of with above order.
