1. The petitioner has approached this Court seeking grant of anticipatory bail in respect of a case registered vide FIR No.0742 dated 26.07.2018 at Police Station City, Thanesar, District Kurukshetra, under Sections 406/420 IPC.
2. At the time of issuance of notice of motion, the following order was passed:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a false allegation has been levelled against the petitioner mainly on account of the fact that there was some dispute regarding monetary transaction between the petitioner’s husband and the complainant who were earlier both working together as financiers.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the falsity of the allegations would be evident from the fact

that the complainant had earlier filed complaints in respect of the same very amount which is mentioned in the FIR and that in the said complaints (Annexure P-1 to P-3) filed under Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act, no details in respect of the liability for which the cheques were allegedly issued by the petitioner's husband has been mentioned.

3. Learned State counsel upon instructions has today informed that the petitioner has been found innocent and that as such he is not required for any custodial interrogation.
4. In view of the aforestated position, the petition is accepted and the interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 21.12.2020 are hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
