Through this writ petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner prays for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing notice dated 28.09.2020 (Annexure P-1), 07.10.2020 (Annexure P-2), 20.10.2020 (Annexure P-4), 04.11.2020 (Annexure P-5), 17.11.2020 (Annexure P-7) and 25.11.2020 (Annexure P-10).

It is the pleaded case of the petitioner that he is working as a Contractor. He was awarded a job contract for road and development works which has been completed. The petitioner claims that now he has been awarded a job contract in Nagaland and he is residing therein.

Learned Senior counsel for the petitioner submits that he is being repeatedly summoned and made to appear before the Committee which is causing harassment to him. He submits that the petitioner has already explained his position before the Committee.

Mr. Lokesh Sinhal, Advocate, who enters appearance on behalf of the respondent-Municipal Corporation, Faridabad, has submitted that the person manning the post of Chief Engineer has been shifted and now a new Committee has been constituted. He submits that the petitioner shall be required to appear only once and thereafter he shall not be required to appear. He further submits that the petitioner would be given at least 15 days notice in advance enabling him to appear.

Keeping in view the aforesaid statement, Mr. Puneet Bali, Sr. Advocate for the petitioner, state that the writ petition be disposed of as such.

Ordered accordingly.
