The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 194 dated 06.10.2020, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 341 and 379-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Nighdu, District Karnal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has not been attributed any injury and it is alleged that he was accompanying the other accused. He also contends that co-accused, namely, Gourav Kumar and another have been granted anticipatory bail by this Court in CRM-M No. 37336 of 2020.

This Court, by order dated 22.12.2020 had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from SI Satyawar, states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the Covid-19 Pandemic, the order dated 22.12.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
