This is a petition for regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. on behalf of the petitioner, in case FIR No.141 dated 30.09.2020 under Section 306 of the IPC, registered at Police Station Jogga, District-Mansa.

[2]. The petitioner by now has remained in detention for more than 03 months and 04 days. After completion of investigation, challan against the petitioner has already been submitted. Charges have been framed. Trial is likely to take its own substantial time, not even the single witness from the prosecution side has been examined.

[3] As such, further detention of the petitioner for an indefinite period is not justified.

[4]. For the aforesaid reasons, without commenting any further on the merits of the present case as a whole, but in view of the detention undergone by the petitioner, the prayer of the petitioner for regular bail is allowed and he is ordered to be released on bail subject to appropriate terms

and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
