Present petition has been filed for direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to take appropriate action against private respondents for illegally trespassing the land belonging to the gram panchayat and for taking illegal possession of the same despite the order passed by the Competent Court of Law in favour of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a complaint/representation has already been made by the petitioner in this regard on 13.07.2021 (Annexure P-4), which is till pending consideration with the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Sultanpur Lodhi, which according to the petitioner, has been forwarded now to respondent No.3 for taking appropriate action, hence, respondent No.3 be directed to take a final decision on the said complaint/representation dated

13.07.2021 (P-4) in a time bound manner by passing a speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Sandeep Singh Deol, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, who has joined the proceedings through video conference, keeping in view the service of advance copy of petition accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3-State.

Learned State counsel raises no objection with regard to prayer of the petitioner for deciding the complaint/representation dated 13.07.2021 (Annexure P-4) by respondent No.3 in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in complaint/representation dated 13.07.2021 (Annexure P-4), respondent No.3 is directed to decide the complaint/representation dated 13.07.2021 (Annexure P-4) by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.

It is made clear that before passing of any order by the concerned authority, private respondents be given opportunity of hearing so that the appropriate decision is arrived at by the authority.
