Petitioner, herein, *inter alia*, seeks issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondents to grant/release the benefits of revision of pay scale to him in view of judgment dated 13.01.2017 (Annexure P-6).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that qua his grievance, petitioner caused issuance of a legal notice dated 29.07.2019 (Annexure P-10), the same has not been adverted by the respondents till date. Hence, the instant petition.

3. Learned State counsel, on advance service, joins proceedings and submits that competent authority shall take appropriate decision on the pending legal notice dated 29.07.2019 (Annexure P-10).

4. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by any of the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

5. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority to look into the grievance of the petitioner as per legal notice dated 29.07.2019 (Annexure P-

10) and also by keeping in view the contentions raised in the present petition by treating the same as supplementary representation and take a decision, in accordance with law.

6. Let the needful be done within a period of three months from today. If a favourable order is passed, benefit thereof be accorded within 30 days thereafter. It would be appreciated, if the competent authority will go through the contents of notification dated 07.02.2019 (Annexure P-8) before passing the final order.

7. Disposed of accordingly.
