Writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution has been filed for directing the respondent No.3 to consider the claim of petitioners for rechecking of OMR/Answer sheets (P-6 & P-7) regarding the written test for recruitment of Elementary Trained Teachers held on 16.10.2021 on the basis of advertisement dated 30.07.2021.

Learned counsel, on instructions from the petitioners, states that at this stage, instead of pressing the petition on merits, his clients would be satisfied, in case, representations dated 22.10.2021 (P-8); 08.11.2021 (P-10 & P-11), are decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to that limited extent.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Maloo Chahal, DAG, Punjab, who is present through video-conference, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State. Learned State counsel raises no objection against the innocuous prayer made on behalf of the petitioners.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without going into the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.3 to consider and decide the aforesaid representations dated 22.10.2021 (P-8); 08.11.2021 (P-10 & P-11), in accordance with law by passing speaking order, within a period of one week from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
