The matter has been taken up through Video Conferencing.

The present petition is the second one which has been filed by the petitioner under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for the grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.85 dated 08.04.2021 under Sections 323, 324, 326, 506, 148, 149, IPC registered at police station Sadar Amritsar, district Police Commissionerate, Amritsar. The first one being CRM-M-39995-2021 – Vishal vs. State of Punjab had been dismissed by this Court on 24.09.2021 through the following order:-

“The arguments raised on behalf of the petitioner having not received a favourable response from the Bench and not to invite a decision on merits lest it may prejudice the case of the petitioner at a later stage, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present petition.

Permitted to do so.

Dismissed as withdrawn.”

Admittedly, there is no change in circumstance after the dismissal of the first petition through the afore quoted order. That being so, this Court is of the opinion that the instant petition deserves to be rejected especially, when the petitioner is accused of having inflicted a grievous injury on the complainant with a *datar* (sharp edged weapon), which weapon is yet to be recovered from him.
