Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to issue appointment letter in favour of petitioner on compassionate ground for Class-III post.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without going into the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.2-Deputy Commissioner, SBS Nagar, to consider and decide the aforesaid legal notice (P-9) in accordance with law by passing speaking order within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
