The petitioner(husband) has filed this petition against the order passed by the Family Court directing him to pay maintenance *pendente lite* to his wife @ Rs.4000/- per month and Rs.8,000/- per month has been directed to be paid to the child.

The petitioner (husband) is a government employee, drawing salary of Rs.73,000/- per month. He also owns an agricultural land measuring 27 kanals and 2 marlas.

The learned counsel representing the petitioner(husband) contends that in a separate proceeding as well, the court has assessed the maintenance which has not been considered by the Family Court while disposing of the petition.

It is well settled that the maintenance fixed in the various proceedings are required to be accounted for. However, it is evident that this objection was never taken up before the Family Court.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the revision petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file an appropriate application for

adjustment of the amount which is being paid as maintenance in the other proceedings.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
