1. Prayer in the petition under Articles 226 / 227 of the Constitution of India, is for the issuance of a writ, in the nature of Certiorari to set aside the impugned result / final list (Annexure P-7) dated 31.10.2021 for recruitment to the post of Sub Inspector (Male), Police Department, Haryana etc.

2. At the outset, learned counsel contends that the petitioner as per his calculation is entitled to award of 66.80 marks whereas the last candidate selected has been awarded 66.60 marks therefore petitioner is entitled to be selected.

3. Learned counsel contends that the petitioner has submitted representation (Annexure P-8) dated 02.11.2021 in respect of the grievances, which are the subject matter of the instant petition but no decision has been taken on the same till date, therefore, in the circumstances, the petitioner would be satisfied, if the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the same as well as additional comprehensive representation if any on receipt in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion to respondent No.2 only.
4. Mr. Tapan Kumar, learned DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.2 and after perusal of the writ petition states that he has no objection to the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.
5. Accordingly, in view of the statement of learned counsel for the parties but without commenting upon the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No. 2 to consider and decide representation (Annexure P-8) dated 02.11.2021 as well as additional representation if any submitted within 3 days from today in accordance with law after taking into account all aspects of the matter within 04 weeks from today.
6. Petition disposed of with the aforementioned directions.
