The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.43 dated 07.07.2020 registered under Sections 307, 458, 323, 324, 427, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Bajakhana, District Faridkot (however Sections 326, 325 IPC have been added later on).

As per prosecution case, petitioner inflicted blows with baseball bat on the right side chest of the complainant and on the right forearm of Arshdeep Singh. Both the injuries have

been found to be simple.

Petitioner is in custody since 05.09.2020.

Learned counsel for the petitioner refers to the order dated 15.12.2020 passed in CRM-M No.38015 of 2020 titled Gurprit Singh @ Jhagdu Vs. State of Punjab and order dated 18.12.2020 passed in CRM-M No.41443 of 2020 titled Pappa Singh Vs. State of Punjab to seek parity with the aforesaid co-accused who are also attributed simple injuries on the persons of complainant and Arshdeep Singh.

Learned State counsel however opposed the bail on the ground that petitioner is also the member of unlawful assembly. Challan has already been presented.

In view of above, without adverting to the merits of the case, petitioner is ordered to be enlarged on regular bail, subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Nothing expressed hereinabove would be construed to be an expression of any opinion on merits of the case.
